6 Condition of participation

Eligible to participate in this Championship are only the teams of the National Federations who are affiliated with CMAS. Each National team should comply with the rules of championship, the safety conditions set by the Organizers and the CMAS Rules and Regulations.

Every National team should enter not more than two (2) competitors for each individual event and not more than one team in each relay event.

Every National team must bring with it two (2) national flags $(m. 2,00 \times m. 1,00)$ and a CD with the national hymn.

12 CYLINDER FILLING

The organizer guarantees the filling of cylinders for either DIN or YOKE type. The maximum charging pressure is 200 Bars.

In Japan, it is prohibited to bring in cylinder from any other countries and plug it up the air. Unfortunately, therefore, it is not allowed for you to bring cylinders from your country. All cylinders necessary for Immersion are prepared and provided from our association. Please do understand that it is Japan's legal issue. It is in accordance with CMAS Fin swimming Rules. (The same was followed at the First Asian Championship at Tokai Competition.)







13 THE BOOKING & ENTRY FEE

Minimum 50% of total entry fee should be deposited **no later than 31th** August 2005 to guarantee the booking. The balance payment should be made at the arrival. Organizer can accept only cash and wire transfer (bank charges are due for remitter). Entry fee for each participant is **500 US \$** . The organizer will provide:

- Accommodations in hotel in rooms with two, three or four beds.
- Breakfast, lunch and dinner, beginning with the dinner on the 2nd of July until the breakfast on the 10th of July 2005.
- Transportation between Hotel and Swimming pool.
- Participation at the opening and closing ceremony. Extra charges for single room is **60 US \$** per day.

3 stars hotel: **160 US**\$ per extra day, including 3 meals and hotel Swimming pool charges: **50 US**\$ per one lane per hour
